Cast Iron Welding & Metal Stitching Repairs

1902 James & Browne



We were approached by a London College's Student Union to carry out repairs to the engine blocks of a 1902 James & Browne motorcar which the College had owned since 1934.

Repairs were carried out elsewhere previously on the engine blocks, which were now far from satisfactory, so they chose to use our engineers' expertise to complete the job to satisfaction with a very tight timescale, as the veteran car was needed in tip-top condition for competing in the London to Brighton Run in November! The blocks were brought in to our workshop in September with the due date being the end of October as they would still need to get the car MOT'd before the race....



As you can see from the photographs, we carried out all necessary repairs to the blocks using our Lloyds approved fusion welding procedures, with full machining, grinding, crack testing and pressure testing. After fully inspecting, the blocks were sand blasted and a coating of red oxide primer was applied before collection and refit.
