The Larbert 41104 Range

This stove came into our workshop piled on a pallet, looking a sorry sight! To the untrained eye it looked like a pile of scrap, but we "jigsawed" the pieces back into some sort of orderly fashion, and, although there were pieces broken off various components, we were able to remanufacture and weld into place using our approved fusion welding procedure for cast iron.

The 'Larbert 41104' was a portable range, made to service boats, showman's caravans and homes. It originated from the Falkirk area and was manufactured by Dobbie Forbes & Company Ltd at their Larbert Works. Dubbed by its creators "best in the world" and with their "never fail" promise, the stove's marketing was good by anyone's standards! They came in every shape and size and remained in production from the late 19th to the mid-20th century.

Following the welding process, the repairs were ground to the correct profile to match existing

shape, and all components were shot blasted, before the stove was rebuilt and given a black lead coating. And as you can see from the last photograph, back to its former glory!
