Its origins began in 1897 when railway carriage manufacturers De Dietrich started building cars at its plant in the Lorraine region of France. They ceased production of automobiles in 1935 when the plant returned to rail locomotives.

We undertook the welding repairs and modifications using our approved welding procedures for cast iron. All welds were then ground to the correct profile to the required specifications, before pressure testing to ensure sound repairs had been undertaken, then coating with red oxide primer, prior to customer collection and the journey back to Belgium!
