> Welding repairs were undertaken by way of our Lloyds approved fusion welding procedure for cast iron, followed by grinding to shape; shot blasting; pressure testing; crack testing; and finally a coating of red oxide primer.

The "Le Mans" was a 2/4 seat sports car made by Aston Martin between 1932 and 1933 making the cars exclusive - only 130 were produced. The cars were long, low and immediately recognisable by their unique radiator style and had great character making all the appropriate mechanical noises that characterised Aston Martin.
