Cast Iron Welding & Metal Stitching Repairs

Trinity College, Cambridge



We are proud to have been involved in the major refurbishment project of New Court, Trinity College. This Grade 1 listed building which was built in 1825 to a Tudor Gothic design, was to undergo a “retrofit” allowing the student accommodation to become energy efficient, with the façade and windows restored to their former glory.



We were invited to carry out the restoration of the cast iron windows using our metal stitching procedures, ensuring that the area to be prepped was clean before repairing, and then primed in preparation for the top coat (along with double glazing) at a later date.

As this was a major project we worked on the windows over the course of two summers. The project was finally completed in late Autumn, and the bottom photograph shows the court fully refurbished.
